## a student speaking Urdu

My school is called Min Hadj Modern High School in a city called Kamoke, just two minutes' walk from my home in Pakistan

There are 800 pupils. Lessons start at 7:00 in the morning and finish at 1:00 in the afternoon. There is a lunch break at 12:00. The lessons last 60 minutes.

In secondary school, we study, Urdu, English, Maths, Science and Quranic studies. We have assembly every day outside.

We have each subject in a different classroom where the teachers are. All my teachers were women. Boys and girls are mixed in lessons. There are 30 pupils per class but we do not have tutor group.

In my school there is no gym and no library. There is a reception near the Principal's office. He was very nice sometimes teaching sometimes visiting us in the classroom.

I miss my friends but I like it here for my studies and my family.
