There is no entrance cost and we have secured free travel with Transport for London therefore there will be **no travel costs** either.

Your son must arrive at school at 8:30 to register, in **full school uniform** with a waterproof coat if the weather forecast is poor. We will leave school after registration and will be aiming to arrive back by 3:00pm approx. Students will need to bring a **packed lunch (including a non-fizzy drink)** with them as there will be no opportunity to buy lunch whilst on the trip. If your son currently receives Free School Meals, a packed lunch will be provided for him. Your son might want to bring a small amount of pocket money for spending on the day but it will be his responsibility to look after it.

Students will be travelling to and from school/venue as detailed above. If you have given prior consent (on the schools admission form) your son will be dismissed from the return station, if not he will be escorted back to school. If you would like to check this please contact the school office.

As this is a free trip and during school hours students will automatically be on the list to go, if however, you, for whatever reason, do not want your son to go please write to me outlining the reasons.
