Year 11 GCSE Revision Plan

Written Examination: Wednesday 17th May

The theoretical aspect of the course is divided into 6 topics. Each topic contains several subtopics – identified 1.1 to 6.5. The written exam is out of 80 marks, is 90 minutes in length and contains a range of multiple choice questions (worth 1 mark each), short answer questions (ranging from 1 to 4 marks) and two 6 mark extended writing questions.

You need to be able to recall the content of these, and supplement them with notes from the revision guide for homework. You will also receive a small range of exam questions for completion each lesson.
