

## Music

BTEC Level 3 Extended Certificate in Music Performance is equivalent to 1 A Level. This course involves 4 units of which 3 are mandatory and one is optional. Studied over 2 years this course supports progression to a university course in Music.

Ensemble Performance

Professional Practice in the Music Industry

Music Theory in Practice

Optional Unit:

Solo Performing

This is a practical course in which you will learn about performing, arranging, composing and a wide range of different styles of music. Central to the course is development of your instrumental or vocal skills and using these in live performance.

The course will include solo, instrumental/vocal tuition and ensemble coaching. Working with professionals within the music industry. Creating and staging within the school and the community. BTEC Level 3 Music can lead to a career within the music industry or further study at college or university. An active involvement in music performance both inside and outside of school is highly desirable.
