

We recognise that young people grow up in an increasingly complex world and are learning to live their lives both on and offline.


This presents many positive and exciting opportunities, but also challenges and risks. Our vision is for all our students to know how to be safe and healthy and how to manage their


academic, personal and social lives in a positive way.


